

Glazed Red Earthenware (407)

1550-1900

Fine, sandy, pink earthenware fabric with a thin orange, sometimes green, glaze on the inside. Large mixing bowls, cauldrons and frying pans. From 1690 black glaze was also used. Made and used everywhere.
